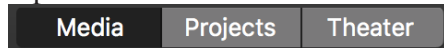

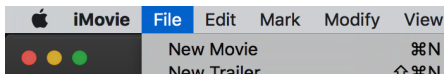
iMovie is Apple's default video editing software, which can be found in the Applications folder of any MacBook or iMac Desktop.

To Create A New Movie Project:

Open the "Media" Tab.



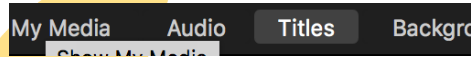
Find the "File" dropdown menu, and select "New Movie"



To import clips, audio, and/or photos, either press Command+I or click and drag the media to the project window.

To Create Titles:

While your movie is open, select the "Titles" tab.



Click and drag the type of title you want wherever in the timeline you want it to occur.

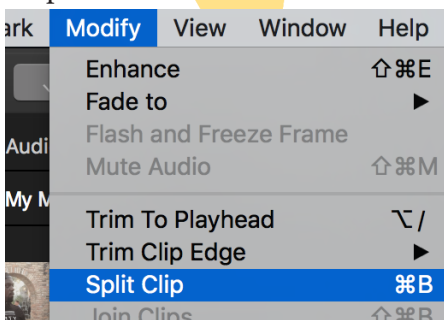
To change the title text, double click on the title in the timeline and type what you want it to say.

To Edit A Movie Project:

To extend or shorten a clip, drag the left or right edge.

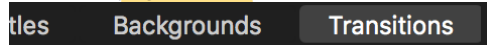
To move a clip, click and drag it to another position in the timeline.

To split a clip, place the playhead over where in the clip you want the split to occur. Find the Modify dropdown menu, and select "Split Clip"



To Add Transitions:

To add one of iMovie's video transitions manually, go to the "Transitions" and drag



To add a cross-dissolve - which allows one clip to fade into the next - click the edge of either clip, find the Edit dropdown menu and select "Add Cross Dissolve".
