
#### HUGHES CIRKUT NEGATIVES

The Hughes Cirkut Negative Collection consists of 457 negatives taken between 1916 and the mid-1940s. All are approximately 10 inches wide range in length from under 20 inches to over 50 inches. Subjects include industrial plants, military units, city skylines, compancy picnics and many others.

The following description of the collection consists of a list of the negatives by storage location (item number). It also includes name, date, place, number of negatives in a box or roll and any additional description.
